

Per CA HSC Section 25230.15, preservative treated wood shipped to wholesalers or retailers in California must include information on proper management and disposal.

Proper Management:

- Preservative treated wood should be used in accordance with Safety Data Sheets: PreservedWood.org/how-to/find-sds.
- Wear gloves, eye protection, and a dust mask when working with wood.
- Do not burn preservative treated wood waste (TWW) or use it for mulch.

Proper Disposal:

- Anyone working with or removing preservative treated wood must ensure that the TWW is disposed at a composite lined landfill, approved by the SWRCB, listed here: wwpi.info/CalTWWLandfills.
- Dispose of all TWW appropriately, including sawdust and scraps.
